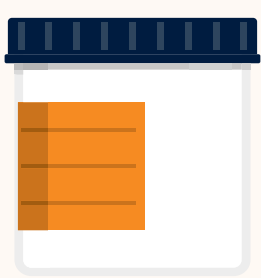


Standard of care in **CLINICAL DRUG TESTING**

The most common practice of physicians
is to use a combination of:

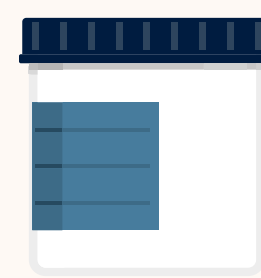
PRESUMPTIVE + DEFINITIVE TESTS

on the same specimen,
to fully confirm drug adherence or misuse.



PRESUMPTIVE TEST:

Rapid, qualitative
results at the point
of care



DEFINITIVE TEST:

Highly sensitive lab tests
that can confirm or refute
presumptive test results



88% of physicians recently
surveyed agreed that clinical
drug testing is **CRITICAL TO
