



# The difference in **DRUG TESTS**

## **PRESUMPTIVE TESTS**

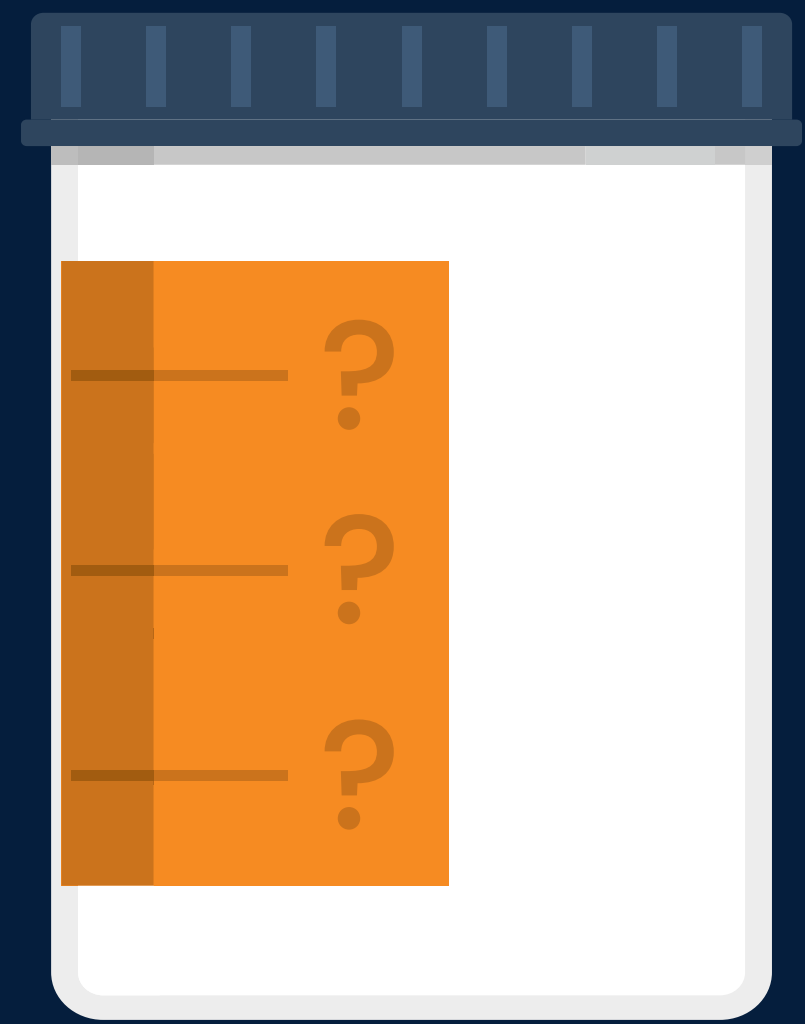
- Rapid, point of care tests
- Qualitative results
- Often have lower sensitivity, may miss positive results
- Often labeled as screening test

## **DEFINITIVE TESTS**

- High sensitivity lab tests
- Quantitative results
- Can confirm or refute presumptive test results



Roughly **HALF** of all physicians who have prescribed controlled substances in the past 6 months do not order definitive testing for positive (51%) or inconclusive (47%) presumptive results, and may potentially be missing identification of misused drugs.<sup>1</sup>



## **WHEN ONLY USING PRESUMPTIVE TESTS, HERE IS WHAT **MAY BE MISSING****

Fentanyl	74%	Methamphetamine	16%
Marijuana	29%	Oxycodone	11%
Amphetamine	17%	Cocaine	7%
